1. INTRODUCTION

The Harry Gwala Development Agency (HGDA) is a special purpose vehicle to manage and implement development projects within the Harry Gwala District Municipality (HGDM). The Agency's offices are built on a thatched roof structure and considerable care should be given as and when any maintenance work or any service is to be provided.

2. PURPOSE OF THE BRIEF

The Harry Gwala Development Agency (HGDA) seeks to procure the services of a suitably qualified service provider to submit a quotation for the supply, delivery and installation of nine (9) green waterproof shade cloth carports (with a 5-year warranty) at its offices. The main purpose is to safeguard the vehicles of the Agency staff and visitors from exposure to sun, rain and hailstorms due to inclement weather conditions.

3. DETAILED SCOPE OF WORK

The service provider is expected to supply, deliver and install new green waterproof shaded cloth carports that are engineered to be durable and long-lasting, made from high-quality material and are resistant to rust (Galvanized), decay, and the corrosive effects of weather with low maintenance.

The installation of carports will consist of the following works:

Supply, delivery and installation of nine (9) units, new covered carports as below:

- Galvanized Steel Poles of 76mm x 76mm x 5m with 600mm underground depth. Above ground 2400mm (height of pole)
- Roofing- Dome-shaped waterproof, sun resistant, low maintenance with 5-year guarantee.
 76mm x 76mm x 6.2m
- Concrete Foundation: Concrete work should be in line with the SABS 1200G regulations. The concrete foundation must be 25 MPA.
- Provision for Earthworks: provide and supply for ground preparation prior ground development. The contractor must make provision for ground preparation.
- Project Completion: Handover will be applicable when the project is in complete working order
 and all work and services as set out in an orderly manner. All materials used should have a 5year warranty. The contractor must also provide documentation on the guarantee of work
 completed. Each set of car ports should allow any further additions to the structure.

1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

2. **DEFINITIONS**

- (a) "tender" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation to provide goods or services through price quotations, competitive tendering process or any other method envisaged in legislation.
- (b) "price" means an amount of money tendered for goods or services, and includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (c) "Rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- (d) "tender for income-generating contracts" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and
- (e) "the Act" means the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

3. FORMULAE FOR PROCUREMENT OF GOODS AND SERVICES

3.1. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

3.1.1 THE 80/20 OR 90/10 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

80/20

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

$$Ps = 80 \left(1 - \frac{Pt \ Pmin}{Pmin}\right)$$
 or $Ps = 90 \left(1 - \frac{Pt \ Pmin}{Pmin}\right)$

Ps = Points scored for price of tender under consideration

Pt = Price of tender under consideration
Pmin = Price of lowest acceptable tender

3.2. FORMULAE FOR DISPOSAL OR LEASING OF STATE ASSETS AND INCOME GENERATING PROCUREMENT

3.2.1. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

$$Ps = 80 \left(1 + \frac{Pt - Pmax}{Pmax}\right)$$
 or
$$Ps = 90 \left(1 + \frac{Pt - Pmax}{Pmax}\right)$$

Where

Ps = Points scored for price of tender under consideration

Pt = Price of tender under consideration

Pmax = Price of highest acceptable tender

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

- 4.1 In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
 - (a) an invitation for tender for income-generating contracts, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the highest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system; or
 - (b) any other invitation for tender, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the lowest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system,

then the organ of state must indicate the points allocated for specific goals for both the 90/10 and 80/20 preference point system.

CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION

- This Municipal Bidding Document (MBD) must form part of all bids invited.
